




The M. Pharm students, accompanied by faculty members, were welcomed by the officials of IPC. The visit was structured into several segments to provide a comprehensive overview of the Commission's operations and responsibilities. The visit began with a detailed presentation by IPC representatives, highlighting its role as the national standard-setting body for pharmaceuticals in India. Key aspects discussed included preparation and revision of the Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP), functions of the National Coordination Centre (NCC) for Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI), quality standards and analytical methods for drugs.

The students were guided through the state-of-the-art analytical and quality control laboratories. They witnessed demonstrations of various sophisticated instruments such as High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC), Gas Chromatography (GC), UV-Visible Spectrophotometers, Infrared (IR) Spectroscopy, These instruments are integral to ensuring the safety and efficacy of drugs in compliance with pharmacopoeial standards. A session was dedicated to explaining the operations of the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI). Students learned about the collection, monitoring, and assessment of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs) to ensure patient safety. An engaging Q&A session allowed students to interact with IPC scientists and regulatory experts. Queries related to the formulation of standards, testing protocols, and career opportunities in the regulatory sector were addressed.

The industrial visit to the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission proved to be an enriching experience for the M. Pharm students of Lloyd Institute of Management and Technology. It provided a valuable platform to connect academic concepts with industry practices, fostering a better understanding of the pharmaceutical regulatory landscape.







Chhath: Emotion of Every Bihari Û



156 FDCs BANNED by Indian Govt.

FDCs (Fixed Dose Combinations) are medicines that consist of more than one active ingredient (chemical compound in medicines that have an effect on the body) in a single dose. FDCs are meant for patients with chronic conditions like diabetes.

The Government of India has banned 156 Fixed Dose Combinations (FDC), including popular medicines such as Cheston Cold and Foracet, used for cold and fever. Among the banned FDCs are:

- · Combinations of anti-allergic medicines such as levocetirizine with nasal decongestants.
- · Syrups that break down mucus and paracetamol.
- · Combinations of migraine medicine with anti-emetics.
- · Combinations of mefenamic acid with anti-fibrotic medicine such as tranexamic acid.

These 'ludicrous' combinations have been banned because they contain ingredients that either do not work well together or have ingredients that are not needed by patients to be taken together. Despite the earlier bans, a 2023 study found that FDCs as a proportion of total antibiotics sold in India had actually increased from 32.9% in 2008 to 37.3% in 2020. Manufacturers have been told to immediately stop producing, stocking, and selling these drugs, according to the government notification. Be thowever, they are likely to remain available in the market for some time.
