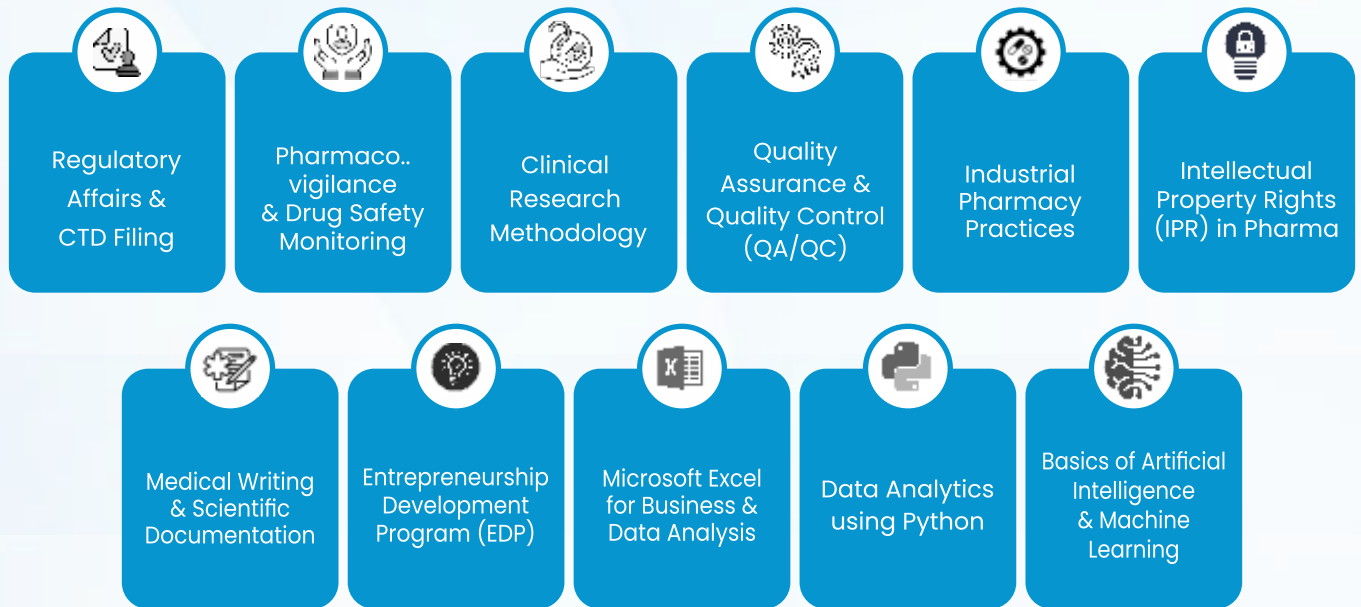

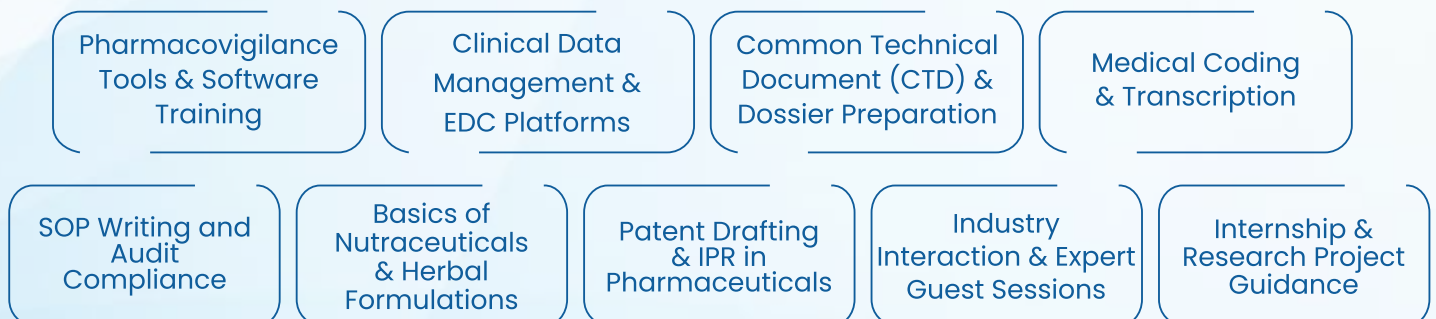

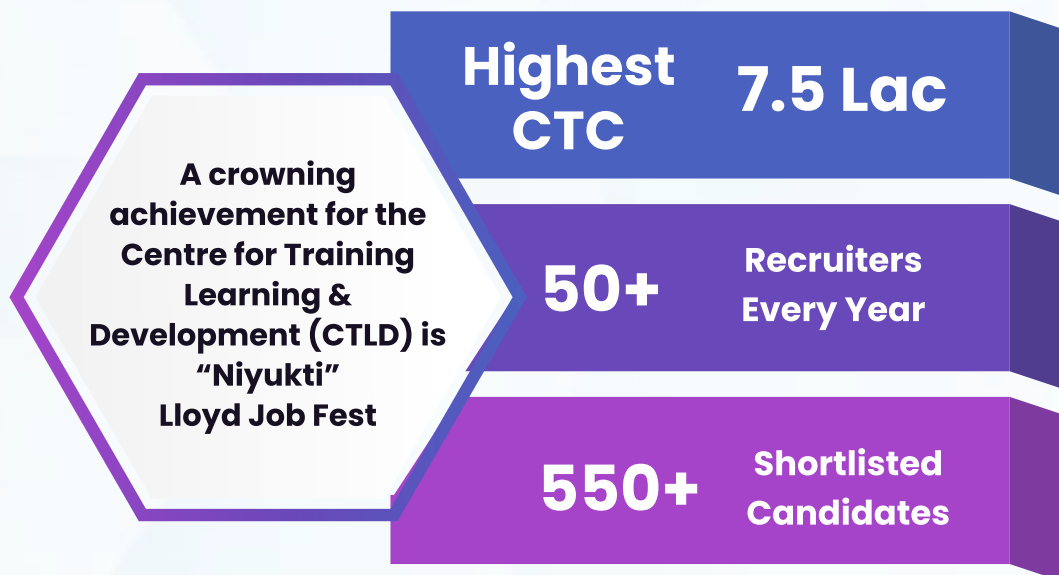

To date, more than **2,000 students** have secured their **First job** through this transformative platform

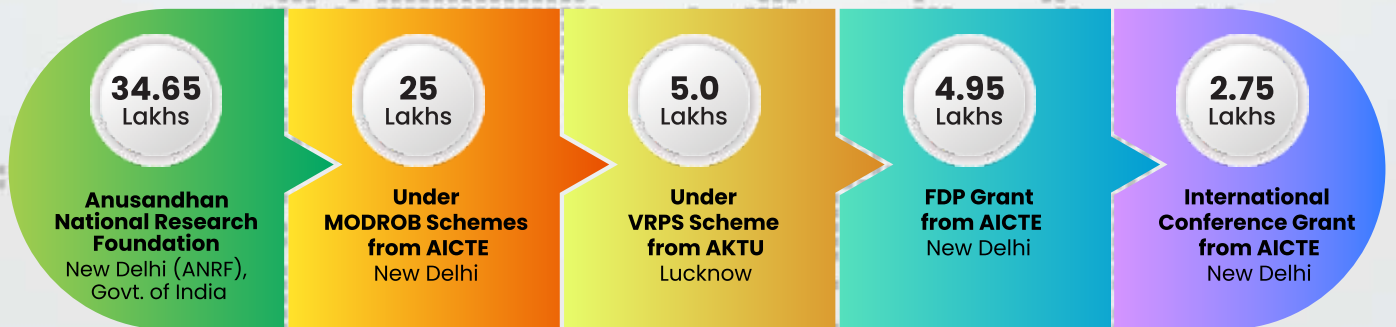
